COUNSELLING AND GROUPWORK

WHAT IS COUNSELLING?

We offer one-to-one sessions with a trained counsellor where you can talk about your experiences and your feelings. Our counsellors don't judge or advise but offer a supportive, safe and confidential environment to talk and be heard.

HOW LONG WILL IT LAST?

We offer everyone up to 12 sessions of counselling. If you would like further support there is the possibility of extension, according to need. We have a sliding scale of fees and charge you according to your income.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Contact us to sign up for counselling, or you can fill in a form on our website. We will then arrange an initial chat to discuss how we can best support you. Counselling can be delivered online, face to face, or by telephone by our experienced team of men and women.

WHAT ABOUT GROUPWORK?

INDEPENDENT SEXUAL VIOLENCE ADVISOR (ISVA)

WHAT IS AN ISVA?

Our Independent Sexual Violence Advisors (ISVAs) support men who are thinking about reporting or have reported to the police. Our ISVA service is open to men and boys over the age of 13 and supports those living in London or where the offence happened in London.

WHAT SUPPORT CAN I GET?

Our ISVAs can:

- Provide you with information on the criminal justice process and what you can expect if you report to the police. They can also attend interviews and court with you if you wish.
- · Listen to you and offer emotional support.
- Give you information on other support services.
- · Help you think about your safety.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Our ISVA service accepts self referrals and referrals from third parties. This is a free service.
